

### Sports Premium Swimming

In December the Government has placed an expectation on schools to publish as part of their Sports Premium money, how many children in Key Stage 2 have reached the expectation of being able to swim 25 metres.

Our current Year 6 children have attended swimming lessons as part of the curriculum during Key Stage 2.

Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety	Please complete all of the below*:
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres?	83%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	64%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	64%
Schools can choose to use the Primary PE and Sport Premium to provide additional provision for swimming but this must be for activity <b>over and above</b> the national curriculum requirements. Have you used it in this way?	No
