COVID

From Friday 2nd April all of our schools will be closed, with no staff on site to answer phone calls or deal with queries. From this date, the main responsibility for dealing with positive cases of Covid-19 is the national Test and Trace operation.

The DFE have asked school leaders to be available to respond to such requests up to Tuesday 6th April.

It is important to note that school leaders will be operating remotely and so will only be looking at seating plans for lessons and tutorial sessions, with the responsibility for identifying social groups being with individual parents and carers when contacting Test and Trace. School leaders will communicate with any families, whose child has been within 2 metres during lessons or tutorials, via email, confirming self-isolation dates.

After April 6th up to and including Monday 19th April, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

FIZZY DRINKS are not allowed in school at any time.
