COVID

From Friday 28th May all of our schools will be closed, with no staff on site to answer phone calls or deal with queries. From this date, the main responsibility for dealing with positive cases of Covid-19 is the national Test and Trace operation.

To support Test and Trace, we will have a dedicated email address linked to each school, should you need to report a positive case of Covid-19 to us.

The DFE have asked school leaders to be available to respond to such requests up to Tuesday 1st June.

It is important to note that school leaders will be operating remotely and so will only be looking at seating plans for lessons and tutorial sessions, with the responsibility for identifying social groups being with individual parents and carers when contacting Test and Trace. School leaders will communicate with any families, whose child has been within 2 metres during lessons or tutorials, via email, confirming self-isolation dates.

After June 1st up to and including Monday 7th June, parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

Enjoy the holidays with the easing of restrictions, especially being able to spend time with loved ones safely within the government guidelines.

We look forward to welcoming you all back on Monday 7th June.

Please ensure that all School Uniform, PE kits including pumps, trainers and coats are clearly labelled with your child's name.


Unfortunately we cannot return lost property that is not named.

Timekeeping

Lesson's are starting straight away as children go into class. If your child is late they are then missing part of their lesson time. Please ensure children are **on time at the correct entrance.**

Guidelines

COVID restrictions are slowly being lifted which is great news, however to ensure the safety of all children, families and staff we shall be maintaining the current times and procedures in place (school opening plan).

Only Reception parents are to us the Reception gate as they must collect their children from here.

You CANNOT use this as a cut through from the playground to the front of the school.

Chairs blocking this off MUST not be moved in order to maintain the schools opening plan.

Please call or email the office if you need to speak to a class teacher, they will then contact you at a convenient time. Unfortunately there is not time for teachers to speak to parents as children go into class in the morning.

If you have any concerns about COVID, please call 111 who will advise you of the up to date procedures. If a household member displays any symptoms please call 119 to book a test and isolate as a household and INFORM SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY.

If you do report your child absent due to illness please state the full reason as this must be recorded.
